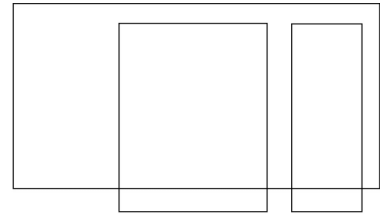
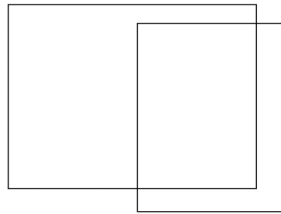
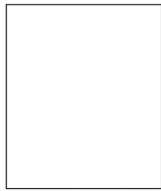

UWT Master Plan: What Do You Think?

- Don't close Jefferson Avenue
- Do put in pedestrian crossings.
- Be urban!
- Polka dot chessboard sidewalks would be something super urban
- Incorporate contaminated soils mitigation with student projects
- Need more opportunities for student input
 - Attend student organization meetings in the fall?
- Green roof funding opportunities might be available
- Marketing arms of Business School and fundraising/non-professional program management might be able to help with funding opportunities.
- Urban Studies program should be pulled in for input.
- Students need hang out space that's convenient.
- Organic food opportunities would be good for residential and non-residential students.
- The Swiss needs to stay.
- Incorporate every academic major into this project: super buy-in, alumni pride
- Social Work program: tremendous opportunity for them to integrate learning and practicum opportunities
- Sustainability is important
- Plan should support the evolution of programs
- Consider retail "hub" like the University Village
- Consider retail as opportunity to showcase student work
- Provide public spaces where student and community can express themselves (political, etc.)
- Early Childhood Learning Center combined with child care would be good
- Need a theater/performing arts facility
 - Open to community
- Consider outreach to prospective students
 - Community college, high school seniors, etc
- Be smart about plant selection
 - Native, toxic-cleaning, etc.
- Incorporate accessibility throughout campus
- Provide opportunities for exercise – fitness course?

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- *The Swiss is a popular community space with a long, important history and strong connection to UWT.*
- *Need more attention to long-term implications to landscaping*
 - *Provide well-maintained green spaces that do not overgrow too quickly*
- *Consider how public transit flows through campus*
- *Feature stormwater collection through the open spaces*
- *To keep view of Mt. Rainier, building has to be low at Market Street (Alternative 1)*
 - *Spaces may have a tendency to be underutilized (Alternative 1 – seems less connected)*
- *Carlton Building – to be acquired?*
- *Are there height restrictions?*
- *West of Tacoma Ave - great site for housing development and connection to hospital*
