#### Carwein Auditorium

Our 162 seat Carwein Auditorium in the Keystone Building is the perfect setting for lectures, guest panels and film viewings. The seating is split between the first floor (120) and the mezzanine (42) with each seat having access to a fold-down writing surface. The auditorium is fully equipped with, audio visual support available.



#### Classrooms

- 34 general-use classrooms
- 5 general-use computer labs
- Room capacity ranges from 20 to 106

#### William W. Philip Hall

Our newest building on campus is the William W. Philip Hall which incorporates four spaces into one. The two largest spaces are the Milgard Assembly Room and Jane Russell Commons which can seat:

- Up to 460 people lecture-style
- Up to 300 people banquet-style (30 tables with 10 seats each)
