The University of Washington Tacoma's Education Program offers this scholarship for a graduate student enrolled in or applying for the Teacher Certification Program (K-8, K-8 with Special Education, Secondary Science) to obtain an initial teaching certification. Students from diverse backgrounds are strongly encouraged to apply.

The scholarship will be awarded to a student based on academic merit, and additional preference shall be given to students who demonstrate a capacity, through their personal background and/or professional record, to contribute to the diversity of the University community and whose future professional contribution in the field of education are likely to benefit a diverse population of students.

Provided that a recipient has made acceptable progress toward his or her degree, this fellowship may be renewable, however priority may be given to support a student who has not yet attained a Washington elementary or secondary teaching certificate.

- Academic merit and ability to maintain good academic standing
- Acceptance in the UW Tacoma Education Program Teacher Certification Program
- Preference may be given to students from diverse backgrounds

- Completed UW Tacoma Douglas and Belinda Louie Scholarship application form.
- Transcripts of all undergraduate coursework (unofficial copies are acceptable).
- Personal essay on topic outlined in application form.

Application must be received in the Education Program office (WCG 324) by May 1, 2009 to be considered. **LATE OR INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.** Notification of results will be made by June 1.
