



## Transfer Planning Worksheet for Interdisciplinary Arts and Sciences

You may use this worksheet to evaluate your transfer credits. Completion of a transfer associate degree will fulfill all of these requirements except Foreign Language. **The Environmental Science degree and Environmental Studies Concentration have additional prerequisites. REQUIREMENT	ALREADY COMPLETED	STILL NEED TO TAKE
<p><b>Foreign Language</b></p> <p>Two years of one foreign language in high school or two quarters of one foreign language in college. American Sign Language may be used to meet this requirement. College-level foreign language can also be counted towards the VLPA (Humanities) requirement. Students whose native language is not English may be exempt from this requirement.</p>		
<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> <p>Three years of high school math to include algebra, geometry and second-year algebra or a course in intermediate algebra at the college level.</p>		
<p><b>Quantitative/Symbolic Reasoning (5 credits)</b></p> <p>A course in quantitative or symbolic reasoning above the level of intermediate algebra (e.g., logic, statistics, Math 107, microeconomics). <i>Students who enrolled in college for the first time prior to Autumn 1985 are exempt from this requirement.</i></p>		
<p><b>Writing (15 credits)</b></p> <p>Five credits of English composition, plus 10 credits of writing-intensive courses are required. The writing-intensive courses may also count toward the Humanities, Social Science or Natural Science requirements.</p>		
<p><b>Visual, Literary and Performing Arts* (15 credits)</b></p> <p>Courses that satisfy the Humanities requirement for an AA/AAS degree from a community college. These may include ART, COMM, DANCE, DRAMA, ENGL, MUSIC, PHIL, PHOTO, SPCH.</p>		
<p><b>Individuals and Societies* (15 credits)</b></p> <p>Courses that satisfy the Social Science requirement for an AA/AAS degree from a community college. These may include ANTHR, GEOG, HIST, PHIL, POLSCI, PSYCH, SOC.</p>		
<p><b>The Natural World* (15 credits)</b></p> <p>Courses that satisfy the Natural Science requirement for an AA/AAS degree from a community college. These may include ASTR, BIOL, CHEM, GEOL, HSCI, MATH, PHYS</p>		
<p><b>Electives* (varies)</b></p> <p>Other courses as needed to make a total of 90 transferable credits.</p>		

\*These requirements may also be fulfilled by approved upper-division equivalents taken at UWT.
