The Americas Communications Manager will support the implementation of communications and marketing strategies for MSC in the region and will contribute to MSC's global communications work. The person in this position will be an integral part of the MSC Americas regional team and will work with a variety of global MSC colleagues and stakeholders, members of the media, fisheries, commercial partners and the conservation community.

The Communications Manager will be responsible for press releases, research and writing projects, development and production of print and electronic materials, media relations, leveraged marketing campaigns, event planning and coordination, consumer outreach and other essential communications support.

The successful candidate will have five plus years of relevant communications experience, and excellent professional and interpersonal skills.
