- Accurate record keeping of lab procedure
- Keep accurate records of experimental data
- Provide ready access to all experimental data for P.I. and/or supervisor
- Prepares culture media, compounds and reagents;
- Decontaminates, cleans, and sterilizes glassware and other materials
- Prepares various chemicals according to instructions and fills containers
- Perform other relevant lab duties provided by supervisor

High school graduation or GED certificate; OR one year's experience as a Laboratory Helper or equivalent.

Knowledge of: elementary bacteriology and chemistry; routine laboratory procedures; mathematics.
Ability to: use common laboratory equipment; follow oral and written instructions.
