You have just taken a step toward becoming more involved at the University of Washington Tacoma! The student government at the University of Washington Tacoma is made up of a diverse group of energized students who represent student interests, needs and welfare within the university community through advocacy and involvement. We do this in order to ensure UW Tacoma students receive an optimal educational experience both inside and outside the classroom.

The Student Technology Fee Committee (STFC) provides an opportunity for students to direct the allocation of student fees, typically toward student-centered initiatives, programs, and services. Members of this important committee will be given an excellent opportunity to provide insight, interact with a broad representation of students, gain skills in a budgetary process, and be involved on a University committee.

Members of STFC are appointed by the ASUWT Senate. All members of the committee are to be students at-large who hold no other appointed position with ASUWT, except for the STFC Co-Chairs. Other members of the STFC include non-voting ex-officio members who will help to ensure that important decisions are made with the necessary background information and utmost care.

Membership in the STFC runs from about mid-November to late June every year. Meetings are held approximately 3-4 times a quarter during autumn and winter quarters, and twice a month or weekly as needed during spring quarter. Additionally, trainings will be provided in order to help STFC members understand their role, become familiarized with Robert's Rules of Order, and other training topics.
