



ASUWT MINUTES

February 24, 2009 - 12:30 P.M. - CP 206C

A Senate meeting was held on February 24, 2009 in CP 206C at the University of Washington Tacoma. The meeting was called to order at 12:40 p.m. by Vice – President Cruz Credle. Senator Nesbitt motioned that Senator Johnson’s name be struck and replaced with Senator Brown’s name. Senator Audett seconded the motion. All members were present. The approval of the Minutes from February 10th, 2009 passed unanimously. There was no old business to address.

Bill #026-F08 was introduced by President Bauer in order to approve the Bill Titled: Elections Procedures. Senator Brown made a motion to accept the bill. Senator Arroyo seconded the motion. After much debate Senator Nesbitt motioned to amend bill #026-F08 by striking the phrase “ASUWT approve the attached elections documents for 2009” and replacing it with the phrase “ASUWT approve the attached Position Description and Spring Elections Packet for 2009.” Senator Audett motioned to make an amendment to Position Description by adding “Check email and office mail box daily responding within twenty-four (24) hours to any requests” to the description of Vice-Presidents duties. Senator Audett motioned to approve Bill #026-F08. Bill #026-F08 was passed unanimously.

Senator Fernandez and Senator Pomeroy from the Legislative Affairs Committee announced that there is a possibility of a 13% increase to tuition. They also announced that they would be promoting their ‘Take 5’ event in the near future. They will also continue a marketing initiative to revitalize interest by the student population in the LAC committee.

Senator Brown from the Student Campus Enhancement Committee announced that he aims at revitalizing the SCEC this quarter. Senator Audett from the Public Relations committee made an announcement about the upcoming Husky Huddle, Elections Packet, and progress of the Graduation Committee. Senator Arroyo from the Student Technology and Fee’s Committee gave an update on progress and completion of the STFC Policies and Procedures as well as its By-Laws. He mentioned that STFC is now reviewing proposals that were submitted to the committee.

President Bauer announced that ASUWT received 14 applications for the open Senate seat. Vice-President Credle announced that the By-Laws and Constitution have been completed and are waiting for approval. He also announced the formation of a committee that would address the increase of the fee by the SAFC.

Senator Audett motioned to adjourn the meeting. Senator Nesbitt seconded the motion. Vice-President Credle adjourned the meeting at 1:27 p.m.
