



ASUWT MINUTES

May 20th, 2009 – 12:35 p.m. – CP 206C

An ASUWT meeting was held on May 20th, 2009 at 12:35 p.m. Vice-President Cruz Credle brought the meeting to order at 12:37 p.m. The meeting minutes from May 12th, 2009 were passed unanimously. There was no old business. Senator Rai Nauman Mumtaz moved to call an Executive Session at 12:40 p.m. Vice-President Credle brought back the meeting at 1:55 p.m.

Senator Mitch Pomeroy moved to amend the agenda to state 'Resolution #3' instead of 'Bill #043-F08.' The amendment passed unanimously. Resolution #3 was introduced by Senator Pomeroy and Senator Mumtaz regarding the UWT Honor Creed. Senator Audett mentioned that this is a resolution and it is not a plan that is set in stone. Senator Elise Nicholl moved to change all occurrences of 'UWT' to 'UW Tacoma.' The amendment passed unanimously. Senator Randy Brown moved to vote on Resolution #3. Senator Mumtaz seconded the motion. Resolution #3 passed unanimously.

President Tommy Bauer mentioned that there would be more budget cuts for the university. Vice-President Credle announced that the results for ASUWT's Special Election would be available at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 21, 2009. Senator Pomeroy announced that he had a copy of the summary of each bill that is presented to the Board of Regents at the University of Washington. Senator Audett asked if he could e-mail it to everyone.

Senator Mumtaz from the Student Campus Enhancement Committee announced that Senator Brown successfully had the hours of the Mattress Factory Building extended to 1:00 a.m. These hours would be effective Monday through Thursday. He also announced that the video conferencing project would continue to be a project of the SCEC and that the SAB would be helping them with their efforts.

Senator Audett from the Public Relations Committee mentioned that she posted the times that everyone is supposed to be volunteering at for the Open Public Forum on Thursday, May 21st, 2009. Senator Arroyo from Student Technology and Fee Committee announced that they had finalized all the letters for STFC.

Senator Brown moved to adjourn the meeting. Vice – President Credle adjourned the meeting at 1:30 p.m.
