



ASUWT MINUTES

June 26, 2009 - 12:30 P.M. - MAT 107

The first ASUWT meeting for the year 2009-2010 was held on Friday, June 26, 2009 at 12:30 p.m. in MAT 107. The meeting was called to order by Vice President Credle at 12:40 p.m. All Senators were present at the meeting. There was no Old Business to discuss.

Resolution #01-F09 regarding the new Constitution and Bylaws was introduced by Vice President Credle. Vice President Credle recognized Adviser, Bernie Liang, to the floor who stated that all the Senators were voted under the old Constitution and thus the resolution would officially have ASUWT operating under the new Constitution & Bylaws so there would be no disconnect between the old and the new. Senator Wheeler asked if the postponing the resolution would help with a current situation. There was discussion that postponing the resolution would not really be an option as the Constitution went into effect the day that it was signed by the Chancellor and President of ASUWT. All were in favor for the resolution. Resolution #01-F09 was passed.

Bill #01-F09 regarding the impeachment of President Elect Long was introduced by Vice President Credle and Senator Wheeler. Vice President Credle went over the accounts in which President Elect Long was indicted. The former resolution passed by the 2008-2009 Senate requesting his resignation was ignored. According to the Constitution, Senators would not be able to impeach the President Elect until a Judicial Board is in place.

Senator Torgerson proposes that the bill be tabled until a Judicial Board is assembled so this can be handled in an appropriate manner. Senator Wynn seconded the motion.

Vice President Credle motioned to adjourn the meeting. Meeting was adjourned by Vice President Credle at 12:50 p.m.
