Rules and Regulations

In order to ensure a safe and comfortable atmosphere for everyone, please be respectful of others and adhere to the following guidelines:

General Guidelines

- 1) Users are required to check in at the front desk for each visit upon entering the Recreation Center. All members must present a valid UW Tacoma ID in order to use the Recreation Center. Entry of the Recreation Center will not be permitted without valid ID.
- 2) Shoes and appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
- 3) Members are required to pick up after themselves and discard trash and remove personal items.
- 4) During peak hours, or while other people are waiting, please be aware and limit use of gaming and recreation equipment.
- 5) Enjoy food, beverages, and gum outside of computer and electronic gaming areas.
- 6) Please refrain from the use of vulgar, obscene, abusive, derogatory and demeaning language, comments, and/or gestures.
- 7) University of Washington Tacoma is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 8) Please report all injuries and any equipment failures to a Recreation Center staff member.

Gaming Guidelines

- 1) Do not install personal copies of software on any gaming station.
- 2) No IRC and/or file sharing is permitted on any gaming station.
- 3) Do not intentionally disable or modify computer hardware or software. This includes any modification of computer settings.
- 4) Please consume food and beverages outside of the computer and electronic gaming areas.
- 5) Please do not attempt to fix technical problems on your own. Notify a staff member if you need assistance.

Equipment Guidelines

- 1) All equipment is for outdoor play and indoor play only and may not be checked out for outdoor activities outside the fenced premises of the Recreation Center.
- 2) All equipment is checked out on a first-come, first-serve basis. Equipment cannot be reserved.
- 3) If a piece of equipment is damaged or broken, please report it to a Recreation Center staff member.

Users who do not adhere to the Longshoremen's Hall Recreation Center rules and guidelines may have their membership suspended, terminated or revoked.
